



## Radiator Rear Protector Screen



Let's face it peeps; even when the Kettle was first launched, one of its most distinguishing features, was also one of its ugliest. I'm talking about the Radiator or more specifically, the rear of the radiator matrix, which looked like it had come off an Austin Seven assembly line! Suzuki had made a good attempt to make the front and sides quite stylish and somehow, never got around to finishing it. Not only that; left 'unfinished' they are most vulnerable to damage and can quickly become even uglier! Who wants to spend thousands on a restoration, just to fit it with a battered looking Rad, eh? Even if you're not interested in cosmetics, it makes sense to protect your Rad doesn't it?

So here's a solution that not only addresses Suzuki's shortfall and enhances the entire engine /radiator package; it also totally protects the delicate fins of the matrix from any further accidental damage without affecting the efficiency of the radiator in the slightest. The protector screens come as a kit, complete with all fittings and fully illustrated instructions to suit model application. They can be fitted in around 10 minutes, using a bare minimum of tools (2). Quality components have been used throughout, which should ensure that they'll remain looking good for many years.
